



Call for Art Gender Odyssey 2012 Art Exhibit

About the show

As part of the Gender Odyssey 2012 conference, this art show is open to all members of the transgender community, with the goal of providing support, community and opportunities for artistic expression. The artwork will be displayed in the concourse areas of both the Gender Odyssey conference and the Gender Odyssey Family conference, at the Washington State Convention Center in Seattle. Plans are in development to extend the show to a public venue before or after the conference as well. Last year's show was well received and included photography, mixed media, painting, textile, wood carving and video.

Dates

Entry form submission deadline: **June 30**

Delivery of artwork:

Local artists drop off by arrangement.

Shipping delivery deadline: **July 15**

**Shipping costs will be at the artist's expense.*

Exhibition dates: **August 2-5**

Return of artwork:

For local artists, pickup times and locations will be announced.

All other artwork will be shipped back to the artist at artist's expense. Arrangements must be made in advance.

Conditions of Entry

Entry of artwork to this show is open to members of the transgender community. Artwork submitted should be appropriate for family viewing. Mature content may be accepted dependent upon presentation. Feel free to contact the art show coordinator, art@genderodyssey.org, to discuss content questions.

Original 2- and 3-dimensional works and original multimedia works -- subject to technical requirements -- will be accepted.

Display space may be limited so please get your submissions in early. Gender Odyssey 2012 does not guarantee space for all art submissions. Art will be exhibited in the lobby area of the 6th floor WA State Convention Center. While the art/vendor area will be locked during the late evening, Gender Odyssey does not assume liability for art work. Convention center cleaning staff will have access to the area.

Insurance:

Gender Odyssey and Washington State Convention Center will not assume liability for loss or damage of artwork during transit or while on display. Artists may secure their own insurance.

Shipping:

The artist is responsible for transit of submitted artwork to and from the exhibition. Work must be shipped in reusable cartons: use screws only in wooden crates.

Exhibition Agreement:

The artist grants the organizers permission to photograph submitted artwork for publicity, educational and reference purposes.
